1. Welcome to Hunters Village/Tapestry Virtual BW meeting
2. Thank you, Bob Mitchell, for scheduling the FreeConferenceCall.com app for our virtual meeting.
3. Introduction of new BW members.
4. Update from Phoenix Police Officer Sgt. Blake Carlson:
  - a. PPD is down to 1096 officers. No internal transfers are allowed. Approximately 19 officers are retiring/leaving per month. The PPD is only able to replace 8-9 new officers per every 19 departees.
  - b. PPD had 178 days of “field force” (riot police) assemble in downtown, but relatively few of those officers were required as compared to Seattle, Portland, Minneapolis, etc. The County Attorney has been working with the PPD to prosecute violent protestors, though an Assistant Prosecutor was side-lined and all of his/her cases dropped.
  - c. A new Community Action Officer has been assigned to our squad to replace Butch Titus. His name is officer Mario Lozoya; phone 602-534-1745.
