



Motor Assist Program

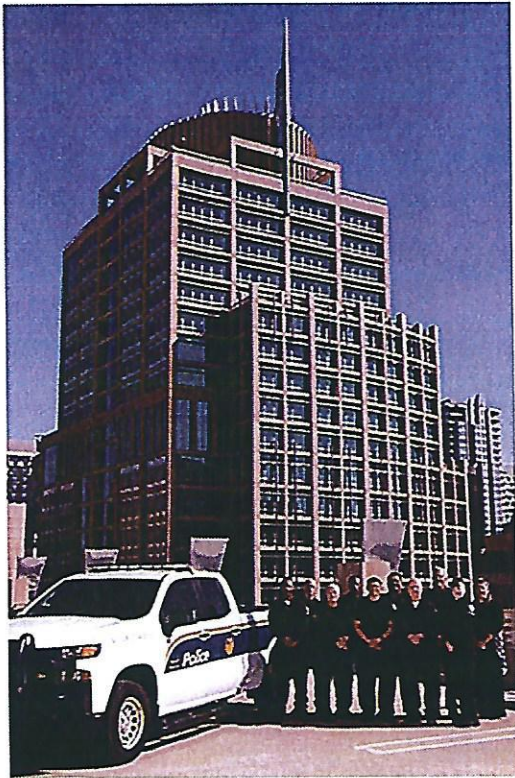
As a MAP Volunteer you help motorists get back on their way after being stranded due to a minor break down or crash.

As a MAP Volunteer you assist sworn police officers & fire fighters at vehicle accident scenes doing traffic control or other non-enforcement duties.

The philosophy of the Motorist Assist Program is service as opposed to enforcement.

Tasks may involve:

- Pushing/jump start vehicles
- Opening vehicle doors using a lockout kit
- Providing fuel, air, or water
- Assisting with changing tires
- Arranging for transportation
- Other assistance reasonably required to aid the temporarily stranded motorist
- Wear a uniform with hat and ID badge
- Drive a marked PPD vehicle

Accessibility Compliance Enforcement

As an ACE Volunteer you help preserve parking spaces for people who need to park close to entrances of places they need and want to go.

You will:

- Educate people on the importance of saving parking spaces for those in need
- Issue a Notice of Violation to vehicles not displaying required disability plate or placard
- Wear a uniform with hat and ID badge
- Serve a minimum of four hours each week. You pick the days and hours.
